in Chamber of Commerce and Industry of Slovenia, Dimičeva 13, Slovenia**

This International Conference has become the traditional meeting of European experts and representatives of the most important institutions in the field of private guarding, especially from European association CoESS and international professional institution FES and from central and Southeast Europe - that is, the states from our direct or nearby neighbourhoods. Among them: especially Croatia, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Serbia, Montenegro, Macedonia, as well from other European states, that is Germany, Austria, Hungary, Bulgaria, Romania. This conference is dedicated to law ordering in filed of private security and in this connections to open most important and actual questions which are in the peak of professional and political debates about concrete difficulties and development dilemmas of private security around Europe. The stress will be made of the necessity of private security as economic activity. Within the frame there are open questions which concern the relationship of the state, especially Police to private security, and on the other part the require of professionalism and attainability of quality at this activities. In that context there are open fundamental dilemma developments of private security, which can not stay unanswered.

In nowadays world the problems of security are becoming all the more acute, as they touch practically everybody - not only the states, their organs and institutions, but the economy as whole and every individual apart. The security is today one of the developing, prospective activities, but also one among most exposed and vulnerable, as it is confronted with multitude of always new risks - moving at the same time along the very thin line that separates the legal action from felony. It seems that we are at the very verge of inescapable demand to introduce some decisive innovations in that activity. The awareness, that the expertise and the quality play the key role, is spreading unstopably. At the same time, the necessity of cooperation is all the more clear, in much broader sense than (as before) defined by the narrow field of private security - or ad hoc demands in some local environments. Taking into account today's extreme mobility, the necessity of certain integral solutions for the whole of European space imposes itself, for quite some time.
